Re: Insurance Sector Assessment

Please find attached an assessment invoice from the Financial Services Commission of Ontario (FSCO). The invoice covers:

- 2009-10 Preliminary Assessment (First Instalment)
- Dispute Resolution Services (DRS) activity charges for the period of January 1, 2009 to June 30, 2009 (if applicable)

The 2009-10 preliminary assessment is based on forecasted expenditures, fees for the full year, and six months of actual Dispute Resolution activity. It is expected that the amount of the second 2009-10 assessment invoice, which will be sent to you in February 2010, will be in the same range as the preliminary assessment. The final 2008-09 assessment will be calculated and reflected on the second instalment of the 2009-10 assessment invoice.

A description of the invoice has been included to provide details of the invoice line items. The determination of each insurer's share of the insurance assessment is made in accordance with Ontario Regulation 11/01 of the *Financial Services Commission of Ontario Act, 1997* (www.e-laws.gov.on.ca).

Please note that the Ministry of Government Services, Ontario Shared Services (OSS), issues the assessment invoice, follows up on any overdue payments, issues monthly statements, and handles general inquiries about the invoice on behalf of FSCO.
